DAY CAMP INSTRUCTOR (2 POSITIONS AVAILABLE)

This position works under the direction of the Program Director to instruct summer day camp participants to paddle canoes and kayaks in a safety first, fun, participation-oriented environment. Most of these program participants will be new to the sport and an important goal of this coaching position is to ensure their first exposure to the sport is a positive experience. Part of your responsibilities will be to assist BCKC's recruitment efforts by encouraging participants to take part in other club programs and club membership. Additional responsibilities such as assisting with lessons & local regattas may be required.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Excellent verbal communication with all ages, especially children aged 8-13.
- Ability to motivate and impart enthusiasm for the sport of canoeing to participants of all ages and backgrounds.
- Bronze cross or equivalent lifesaving certification an asset
- NCCP certification (or in progress) an asset
- CPR-C/First aid training required.
- Pleasure Craft Operator's Certificate is an asset. (We can help in obtaining this.)
- Experience with the sport of canoeing, or an interest in canoe and kayak sport is recommended.
- Self-motivated and a positive attitude towards your work and towards the participants involved in the programs
- Knowledge of BCKC programs and promotion of these programs
- Desire to meet recruitment goals and help BCKC grow

These positions are to be funded by HRDC grant; therefore student applicants must qualify for this funding.
